Membership Meetings

Chief Daryl Mitchell of Cherokee County Fire and Emergency Services spoke at the June meeting about Cherokee County's Technical Large Animal Emergency Rescue (TLAR).

We learned through Chief Mitchell that Cherokee County and the City of Milton are the only two agencies in the State of Georgia that have had specialized training and have a TLAR team. They respond to large animal calls for help, such as a horse who may have fallen in a well or is trapped in a trailer due to a traffic accident.

Cherokee County will offer mutual aid to all of the counties bordering it in case of a large animal emergency rescue. This includes (but not limited to, depending on the need for assistance): Pickens, Dawson, Forsyth, Fulton, Cobb, Paulding, and Bartow Counties.

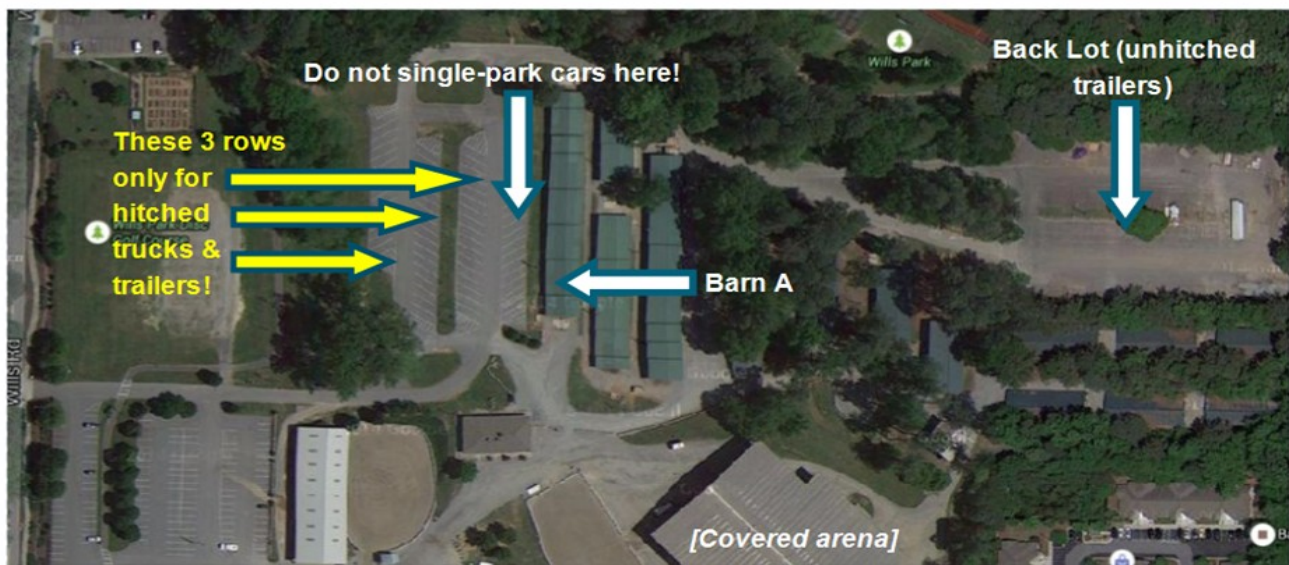
Parking at Willis Park

Several parking issues occurring and a vendor was blocked in at the last show. Please follow these RHSC rules for parking in the lot by Barn A at Willis Park:

Single cars: Do not single-park cars in the parking lot row along barn A. Double-parking with other cars from your barn is OK.

Unhitched trailers: Do not unhitch and drop trailers in the lot by barn A; if you're dropping your trailer, take it to the back lot.

Truck and trailer: You are welcome to park in the lot.
